Thornton Burgess will be on your right, across from the Hampden Country Club and Golf Course. Families and their guests should plan on arriving at 6:20PM. We are planning on starting the show as close to 6:30PM as possible! Everyone is welcome, and there are no ticket or entry fees! All cameras and video equipment is allowed! All children can wear what they choose, as long as they are comfortable and can "sing and move" without being distracted by their clothes or shoes. All students participate in the show, however @20 students will be "graduating" from our program. These students will wear caps and gowns for part of the program, and will be honored during the show.
